

Purpose

Kalpataru initiative seeks help from your esteemed college for volunteers from the Womens club, NCC & NSS to extend a helping hand which will cult the personality development of the students, make them understand the society, be sensitive to other's needs, prepare them to play a positive role in society and to act as a catalyst in bringing about changes in desirable direction.

Background

The Madura College(Autonomous) was started in the year 1889, has been serving the society for one hundred thirty three years for the cause of higher education. When the UGC decided to grant autonomy to colleges in 1978, The Madura College was privileged to belong to the first list of such institutions. The college offers 21 Under Graduate, 13 Post Graduate, 8 M.Phil and 9 Ph.D., programmes. The college, in addition to academics is keen in inculcating social responsibilities to the

students. It has various units like NCC, NSS and RCS and they organize routine activities to develop social sense. The college was awarded by several State and National agencies for its social contribution.

Kalpataru initiative is a CSR Initiative of Arogya Welfare Trust., which commenced in March, 2020 and various activities such as creative reuse of used, unused or underused items are being carried out independently and with collaboration with other institutions.

Kalpataru works on the theme of "Giving for a Cause'. The Project has been receiving home appliances, furniture, household utensils, garments, children's games, toys, books, electrical and electronic items and many more. The goods thus received, are refurbished or repaired and displayed in reusable condition. The donations thus received are displayed and will be contributed to the vulnerable members of the community such as orphans, differently abled and abandoned elders etc. through the Trusts, in and around Madurai. The beneficiaries are decided by Kalpataru.

2. Scope and Responsibilities under this MOU

In particular, this MOU is intended to:

- 1. Provide volunteers to Kalpataru by Madura College, Madurai.
- Kalpataru will inculcate the value of Social service and the concept of creative reuse of used items in the minds of the students.
- 3. Kalpataru will provide opportunity to students so that they imbibe the "Thrift" nature in them.

The request for Volunteers from revered institution Madura College is purposed as below:

- The volunteers duration of this programme will be for a minimum period of one year.
- Depending on the No. of volunteers, they will be grouped as follows:
- a. Stores Volunteers Stores maintenance materials segregation/coding/upkeep of stores/pricing, loading of data in the Master List, materials condition checking/ contacting the vendors for repairs etc.
- b. Materials verification vs the list, in the boxes.
- c. Value of stock vs on hand
- a. Display Volunteers Displaying process laying of stalls, displaying the items, verifying the items displayed with cost. Exhibition checklist verification vs readiness of the display.
- a. Event Volunteers -Organise and coordinate Events at our Deeksha Hall.
- The volunteers of The Madura college may be imbibed with the spirit of collection of used items (home appliances, furniture, household utensils, garments, children's games, books and

anything) from their homes and known contact and will help mobilizing the funds generated through refurbished goods. Kalpataru will take care of transporting the collected materials from the college to Kalpataru's warehouse.

- In general, if they can be made available twice a week, will help in training them through the process. Depending on the total no. of volunteers being given for the initiative, teaming can be done. However, on special occasions (sales day, fund raising event and ICM) the time may be flexible.
- The student volunteers can be involved in organizing the fund-raising events, ICMs and act
 as 'ushers', under the strict guidance of the project Coordinator of The Madura College and
 Kalpataru.
- The student's volunteers will get involved in the activities during their said classes which is conducted every weekdays assigned for them and during special occasions (sales day, fund raising event) without disturbing their academics. During examination period student volunteers need not participate in any of these activities.
- The student participation will be appreciated through a certificate by Kalpataru. The "recognition" for the best performing volunteer will be done by the Kalpataru initiative at the end of the academic year.
- The employed student candidates will work as per the rules and regulations with reference to The Madura college and Kalpataru guidelines framed for student volunteers.
- Both the parties can have periodical meetings to discuss the progress of the work.
- The documented outcome will be presented in the joint name of Kalpataru and The Madura College.
- Students with two shots of vaccine will be permitted to undergo this scheme.

4 Duration and Termination of the MoU

This MoU shall take effect upon signature by the authorities of both parties.

This MoU is valid from the Date of execution by the parties and shall remain in effect for a period of THREES with the mutual written agreement of both parties and may be amended at any time by written mutual consent.

Either party may terminate this MoU at any time without liability to the other on prior written notice of one month.

This MoU does not create binding, enforceable obligations against any party. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Party-A and Party-Band effective from 01-11-2021.
